TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is sanctioned by USBC and all participants must abide by USBC playing rules. Rulings by the Tournament Manager not inconsistent with USBC rules will be final.
2. All female members of the USBC, except professional members, are eligible to participate.
3.
 - i. Handicap allowance will be 75% of the difference between bowler's average and 200. Bowler must use her highest 2008-09 USBC season average for 21 games or more.
 - ii. If current season average for 21 games or more as of January 1, 2010 is 10 or more pins higher, bowler must use that average.
 - iii. Bowlers with no average from 2008-09 must use current average for 21 games or more as of January 1, 2010. All others bowl scratch.
- 3A. USBC Rules 319 d. and 319 e. are waived.
4. If average is not listed in the Syracuse Women's or Men's average book, bowler **must submit verification from league or Association secretary**. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average or cause the prize position to be based on submitted average if it is higher.
5. This is a Singles, double-elimination tournament. A bowler, once qualified, must lose twice before being eliminated. A bowler in the winners bracket will not oppose a bowler in the losers bracket until the final round. The number of qualifiers in match play will be based on the number of entries. It is the bowler's responsibility for accuracy of submitted score and to determine if she qualifies for match play by calling Bowl Mor Lanes at (315) 437-4767.
6. Ties for the lowest qualifying position will be broken by a one-game roll-off at a time to be announced by the Tournament Manager. Losers of such roll-off will be designated alternates. Ties for the other qualifying positions will be broken on the basis of the high game in the qualifying round. Ties in match play will be broken by rolling another 9th and 10th frames, including handicap.
7. Qualifying round will consist of 3 games across 6 lanes. Entrants failing to appear for the qualifying round will forfeit their entry fee. If a bowler is entering a substitute, the Tournament Manager should be notified at least one hour prior to the scheduled time. No substitutes will be allowed once the qualifying round has started. Check-in time is ½ hour before scheduled time.
8. Alternates are allowed only in the first round of match play and will be assigned the position of the qualifier being replaced. Participants failing to appear as scheduled for match play will forfeit the match.
9. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by declared emergency, natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the Tournament Manager shall cause to the extent required thereby all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be pro-rated in accordance with the number of entrants and/or matches bowled up to the time of termination.
10. All accepted entries are final. No refunds will be permitted.
11. *Match play squad times may be subject to change.
12. **Entries need to be completed 100%.**

**Averages for bowlers who qualify for match play will be verified.
Incorrect averages will result in immediate disqualification.**
